



- Bowlers will be recognized in leagues certified by the Central Ohio - USBC and/or when representing the association.
- There will be 4 divisions - Men's, Senior Men's, Women's, Senior Women's.
- Bowlers must have a minimum of 48 games bowled in the CO-USBC to be eligible for All City recognition.
- Points are based on Actual scores - no handicap scores will be accepted.
- Bowlers must participate in at least one event in the CO-USBC City Championship Tournament.
- Averages used will be based on the final averages from the 2025-2026 season as reported by the league secretary.
- It will be the bowler's responsibility to report all qualifying scores for consideration.
- Bowler with the most points in each of the 4 divisions will be selected as Player of the Year for that division.

 260-279 = 20 points for the 1st and 5 points for each additional

Women: 290-300 = 50 points for the 1st and 10 points for each additional
 270-289 = 30 points for the 1st and 10 points for each additional
 250-269 = 20 points for the 1st and 5 points for each additional

Senior Women: 276+ = 50 points for the 1st and 10 points for each additional
 250-275 = 30 points for the 1st and 10 points for each additional
 225-249 = 20 points for the 1st and 5 points for each additional
 200-224 = 10 points for the 1st and 5 points for each additional

TOURNAMENTS:

Adult City Tournament: (separate points for T, D, S, AE)

1st - 50 points, 2nd - 40 points, 3rd - 35 points, 4th - 30 points, 5th - 25 points, 6th - 20 points, 7th - 15 points, 8th-10th - 10 points. All other participants will receive 5 points.

Senior Singles Tournament: 1st - 50 points, 2nd - 40 points, 3rd - 35 points, 4th - 30 points, 5th - 25 points, 6th - 20 points, 7th - 15 points, 8th-10th - 10 points. All other participants will receive 5 points.

CO-USBC Masters and Top Dawg: 1st - 50 points, 2nd - 40 points, 3rd - 4th - 30 points, 5th-8th - 25 points, 9th-16th - 20 points. All other participants will receive 5 points.

CO-USBC QUEENS: 1st - 50 points, 2nd - 40 points, 3rd 4th - 30 points, 5th - 8th - 25 points. All other participants will receive 5 points.

Ohio State USBC Open and Women's Championships: (Separate points for T, D, S, AE)(Actual events only)

1st - 50 points, 2nd - 40 points, 3rd - 38 points, 4th - 36 points, 5th - 34 points, 6th - 32 points, 7th - 30 points, 8th - 28 points, 9th - 26 points -10th - 24 points. All other participants will receive 5 points.

USBC Open and Women's Championships (2026): (Separate points for T, D, S, AE)

1st - 100 points- 2nd-3rd - 90 points, 4th-5th - 85 points, 6th-7th - 80 points, 8th - 10th - 75 points, 11th - 15th - 70 points, 16th - 20th - 65 points, 21st-25th - 60 points, 26th-30th - 55 points, 31st-35th - 50 points, 36th - 40th - 40 points, 41st - 45th - 35 points, 46th - 50th - 30 points, 51st - 75th - 25 points, 76th-100th - 20 points. All other participants will receive 5 points.
